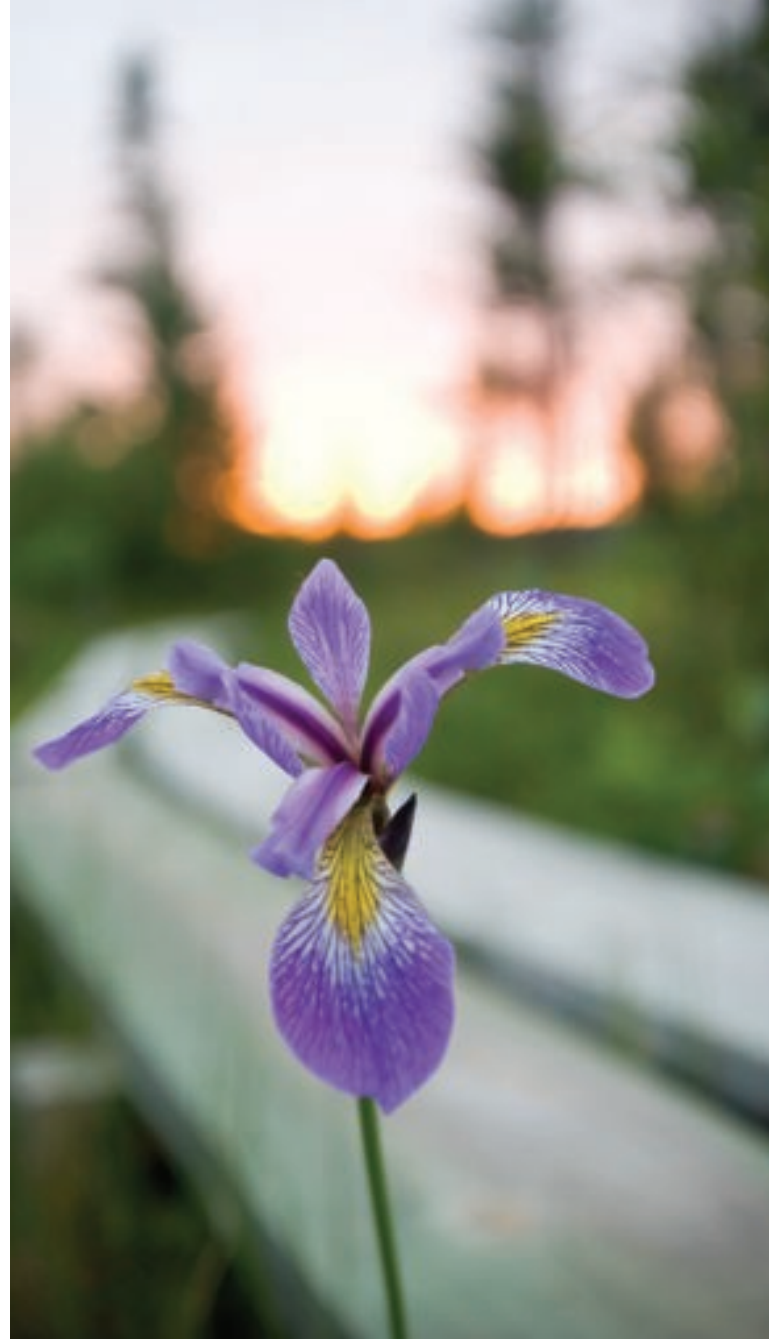

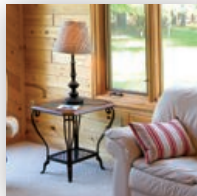
A place of rest and renewal

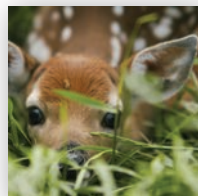

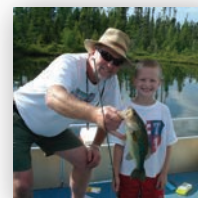
Nature's abundance at your doorstep

Turning Point is a private, 120-acre retreat, which borders hundreds of additional acres of remote, public land. Roughly two miles of trails wind through a variety of landscapes on the property, from open meadows and spruce bogs to old growth forests. The retreat is home to abundant songbirds, grouse, deer and waterfowl, and it features a private, 38-acre lake.



Time for play

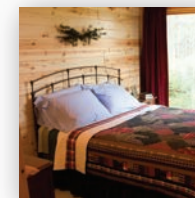
One of the best ways to discover rest and renewal is to dedicate carefree hours to nothing but fun. At



Turning Point, guests enjoy a variety of recreational activities from birding, hiking, cross-country skiing and snowshoeing to bass fishing (catch and release), boating (pontoon, rowboat, canoes and paddleboat available) and swimming. A ping-pong table and yard games are also available.

A home in the woods

The heart of rest and renewal at Turning Point is a bright and modern cabin, which is situated at the end of the retreat's half-mile driveway. The four-season building features an open floorplan and is finished with tongue-and-groove paneling and a simple, Scandinavian décor. With more



than 3,000 square feet of living space, it provides plenty of comfortable spaces for individual relaxation and group activities.

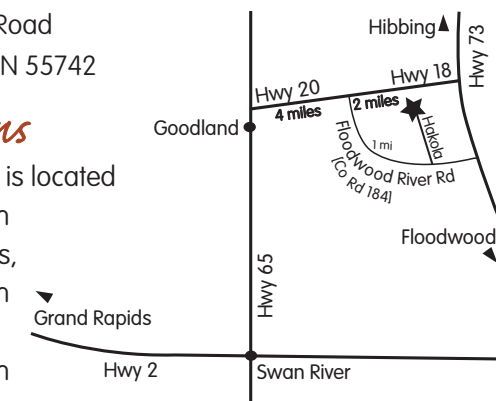
